#5 Plastic: Rigid Containers and Caps with a ♻️ Symbol: Beginning 2025 this type (polypropylene) can go in curbside bins.

Plastic Film (clean, dry, and free of food residue) NexTrex programs accept newspaper sleeves, produce bags, grocery bags, bread bags, Ziploc bags, cereal box liners, dry cleaning bags, bubble wrap, plastic shipping envelopes, air pillows, ice bags, salt bags, wood pellet bags, plastic film labeled with ♻️ or ♻️, case overwrap.
